

Bring back Pittwater Council



We, as residents of the former Pittwater Council Local Government Area, are initiating this proposal to alter the boundaries of the Northern Beaches Council and reinstate the former Pittwater Council under Sections 215 and 218E (2) of the Local Government Act 1993.

We are making this proposal to the NSW Local Government Minister because:

- The forced amalgamation of Pittwater, Manly and Warringah councils was undemocratic and deeply unwanted by the local community
- Pittwater Council provided essential local representation as well as environmental protections for its residents
- Pittwater Council was financially robust and very capable of managing its own financial affairs, and
- An overwhelming majority of Pittwater residents preferred to retain their local council than see it swallowed up in a mega-merger with Manly and Warringah.

We, as enrolled electors in the area that was the former Pittwater Council, propose that:

- The boundaries of the Northern Beaches Council be altered so that the area that was the former Pittwater Council prior to 12 May 2016 be excised
- The former Pittwater Council be re-constituted within the boundaries it held before its amalgamation on 12 May 2016.
